3. Has a small noun-verb vocabulary; Names ten to fifteen objects and a few familiar people or pets.			
4. Uses pronouns <i>me</i> and <i>my</i> .			
5. Names three familiar pictures in a picture book.			
6. Listens to books and stories.			
7. Points to parts of a doll or body when asked (hair, mouth, eyes, ears, etc.)			
8. Complies with simple commands such as coming, retrieving; carries or goes.			
9. Listens with interest to short rhymes and alliterations.			
10. Matches familiar objects as to color, form or size.			
11. Compares familiar objects by color, form or size.			
12. Groups familiar objects by color, form or size.			
13. Counts to at least two.			
14. Is aware of 'one more'.			
15. Knows 'how many' and up to at least 'two'.

30. Toddler can take 5 or more steps backwards without losing balance.			

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31. Walks up stairs by self or by holding onto the wall or railing for support (not crawling or holding on to the next step or a person).			
32. Kicks ball forward.

35. Unwraps: removes covers from objects or peels bananas.
