- ✓ Create a culture of inclusion
- ✓ Use assessment tools to gather data about students strengths & needs
- ✓ Identify strategies to support students
- ✓ Collaborate with student and family to create a MAP
- ✓ Monitor progress and adjust strategies
- ✓ Refer for further diagnostic testing as needed

8. MAP form – Measured Action Plan - A written plan to document strategies and their effectiveness

- ✓ Word document download
- ✓ Documentation form for organization and accountability
- ✓ Provides excellent pre-referral information for public school evaluation referral
- ✓ Updated yearly or more frequently as needed
- ✓ Can rewrite IEP goals on a MAP for implementation
- ✓ Store in cum folder or separate student file
